FORT WAYNE – The Fort Wayne Housing Authority (FWHA) will be opening its Public Housing Program Waiting List on Monday, June 17, 2019 at 8:00am EST. Waiting lists for all bedroom sizes will be available.

Applications will be accepted on-line, by mail, by fax, or in person. The online application portal is accessible through our website's home page at www.fwha.org. The applicant must have a valid e-mail address to apply on-line. If you have clients who need assistance in applying on-line, FWHA would appreciate you assisting them with this very easy process so that they may have the opportunity to participate in this program.

Applicants are reminded that once they apply, they must report all changes in their address or preferences to the Fort Wayne Housing Authority **IN WRITING** within 10 business days of the change. No changes will be accepted over the phone. No mail is forwarded by the U.S. Post Office from the housing authority. If no address change is made with the housing authority and the FWHA receives returned mail, the application will be removed from the waiting list.
